PAROCHIAL FEES ORDER 1999

As Chancellor of the Diocese of Peterborough, **I HEREBY PRESCRIBE AND ORDER** that under the Provisions of Part II of the Parochial Fees Order 1999, where any Faculty is granted for any of the works set out in the table below, the relevant fees specified in the table shall be payable to the Incumbent and the Parochial Church Council by the person or persons for whose benefit the Faculty is granted, unless the Faculty otherwise provides.

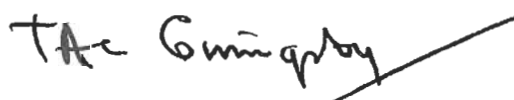
Item	Faculty for	Para.	Incumbent	P.C.C.
1	Burial of cremated remains in or under a Church	4	£60	£120
2	Burial of cremated remains in a closed churchyard (save where burials are authorised by general faculty)	4	£30	£60
3	Erection of monument in a Churchyard	5	£30	£60
4	Additional inscription for monument in Churchyard	5	£20	£40
5	Monument or memorial tablet or plaque in Church	6	£60	£120
6	Additional inscription to an existing monument or memorial tablet or plaque in Church	6	£30	£60
7	Reservation of a grave space	8	£40	£80
8	Reservation of site for cremated remains	8	£20	£40

This Order shall come into force on 1st September 2000

Notes:

- (1) The numbers in the third column refer to the numbered paragraphs in the Parochial Fees Order 1999.
- (2) The fees under Item 2 are only payable if the churchyard is maintained by the P.C.C.
- (3) Where any fees are payable for works under Items 1 to 6 above, they are payable prior to the commencement of the works, and for purposes under Items 7 or 8 on lodging the Petition for Faculty in the Diocesan Registry.
- (4) It is the intention of these Directions that fees payable to the P.C.C. shall be applied to the maintenance and upkeep of the Churchyard, or as the case may be, of the fabric and monuments of the Church either directly or through a capital fund.
- (5) Fees payable to a minister are to be treated by the minister in the same way as other parochial fees, and accordingly, where fees have been assigned to the Diocesan Board of Finance, they are to be accounted for to the Diocesan Board of Finance in the usual manner.
